Personal History

Joseph Arnold HARROP was born at Little Hulton, Bolton, Lancashire on 6 April 1899 the son of Joseph Hague and Ellen HARROP nee LEACH who were married 1887 at Bolton Register Office or Registrar Attended. His father died in 1944. His mother died in 1944.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 78, Manchester Road East, Little Hulton, Bolton,. He was aged 11 with the occupation of Scholar.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 27, Venice Street, Bolton,. He was aged 2 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company as a Clerk

Service History

He was living at 76, Tynesbank, Little Hulton when he enlisted in the Durham Light Infantry at Bolton, Lancashire,. on 14 March 1917

He is recorded as Killed in action on 27 May 1918 aged 19 He was awarded the Victory Medal & British War Medal
