Personal History

Arthur James HART was born at Chester, Cheshire in 1899 the son of Frederick William and Eliza HART nee PARK who were married 1889 at Holy Trinity, Horwich, Lancashire.

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Locomotive Dept. at Horwich as an Apprentice

Service History

He was living at 16.Panton St. Horwich when he enlisted in the Royal Scots Regiment at Bolton, Lancashire, . on 20 April 1915 and embarked for France on 14 October 1915. His last known address was Horwich, Panton Street, 16 (Attestation).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 11 May 1916 aged 17

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
