*Killed in action 11 May 1916 aged 17*

***Personal History***

*Arthur James HART was born at Chester, Cheshire in 1899 the son of Frederick William and Eliza HART nee PARK who were married 1889 at Holy Trinity, Horwich, Lancashire.*

*Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Locomotive Dept. at Horwich as an Apprentice*

***Service History***

*He was living at 16.Panton St. Horwich when he enlisted in the Royal Scots Regiment at Bolton, Lancashire, . on 20 April 1915 and embarked for France on 14 October 1915. His last known address was Horwich, Panton Street, 16 (Attestation).*

*He is recorded as Killed in action on 11 May 1916 aged 17*

*He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star*
