Personal History

Ernest Edward HARTLAND was born at Sowerby Bridge, Yorkshire in 1899 the son of Ernest Benjamin and Ada Sophia HARTLAND nee HIRST who were married 15/08/1898 at Christ Church, Sowerby Bridge, Yorkshire. His father died in 1939. His mother died in 1939.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 3, Lower Bentley Road, Sowerby Bridge,. He was aged 11 with the occupation of Scholar.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 5, Oxford Street, Sowerby Bridge, Yorkshire,. He was aged 2 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company

He enlisted in the Northumberland Fusiliers at Halifax, Yorkshire.

He is recorded as Died of Wounds in Death Presumed aged 18

He was awarded the Victory Medal & British War Medal
