***Personal History***

*Frank HASLAM was born at Irlam-O'th Heights, Lancashire in 1896 the son of James William and Phoebe HASLAM nee PERKS who were married 16/09/1891 at Christ Church, Pendlebury, Lancashire. His father died in 1951. His mother died in 1951.*

*In the 1911 census the family were living at 21, Ruth Street, Bolton, Lancashire,. He was aged 15 with the occupation of Scholar.*

*In the 1901 census the family were living at 274, Bolton Road, Pendleton, Lancashire,. He was aged 5*

*Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Locomotive Dept. at Horwich as a Labourer*

***Service History***

*He was living at Bolton, Lancashire when he enlisted in the Scots Guards at the same place.*

*He is recorded as Died of Wounds on 1 September 1916 in France aged 20*
