Personal History

Herbert John HASTINGS was born at Bury, Lancashire in 1880 the son of Michael and Margaret HASTINGS nee O'SHAUGHNESSY. His father died in 1924. His mother died in 1924.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 9. Wyndham Street, Bury, Lancashire,. He was aged 30. Laboure in Iron Foundry

In the 1891 census the family were living at Wellington Barracks, Elton, Bury, Lancashire,. He was aged 10 with the occupation of Scholar.

He was a married man. His wife's name was Mary HASTINGS (nee ROSTRON) They married at Bury, Registry Office or Registar Atended, on 27 March 1905

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Locomotive Dept. at Bury as a Fitters Labourer

He is recorded as Died at home on 22 October 1916 aged 36
