***Personal History***

*James Henry HAWORTH was born at Darwen, Lancashire in 1881.*

*In the 1911 census the family were living at 108, Exchange Street, Darwen, Lancashire,. He was aged 30 with the occupation of Cab Driver.*

*He was a married man. His wife's name was Gertrude Mary HAWORTH (nee SWINDELLS) They married at St. John, Darwen, Blackburn, Lancashire on 18 March 1905. They had children: Harold b. 1905, Harry Burgess b. 1910, Jack Cooper b. 1913*

*Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company as a Extra Porter*

***Service History***

*He enlisted in the Kings Liverpool Regiment at Darwen, Lancashire.*

*He is recorded as Killed in action on 20 September 1917 aged 36*

*He was awarded the Victory Medal & British War Medal*
