Personal History

John BALDWIN was born at St. Thomas, Lancashire in 1885 the son of Richard and Martha BALDWIN nee MILLS who were married 15/01/1870 at St. Thomas, Wigan.. His father died in 1891. His mother died in 1891.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 14, Stanley Street, Newtown, Wigan,. He was aged 26 with the occupation of Coal Miner.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 37, Baldwin Street, Wigan,. He was aged 16 with the occupation of Coal Hewers Labourer.

In the 1891 census the family were living at 62, Princess Street, Wigan,. He was aged 6

He was a married man. His wife's name was Elizabeth Annie BALDWIN (nee OSBOURNE) They married at St. Mark, Newtown, Wigan on 13 April 1906

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Carriage and Wagon Dept. at Wigan as a Washer

Service History

He enlisted in the Royal Engineers at Wigan, Lancashire. on 5 September 1914 and embarked for France on 9 September 1915. His last known address was Wigan, Newtpwn, Stanley Street, 14 (1911 Census).

He is recorded as Died at home on 27 May 1918 aged 33

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
