Walter HEATON was born at Halifax, Yorkshire,.

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Superintendent of the Line Dept. at Luddenfoot as a Goods Guard

Service History

He enlisted in the Royal Field Artillery at Bradford, Yorkshire. and embarked for France on 7 July 1915.

He is recorded as Died of Wounds on 17 August 1916

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal, 1914-15 Star & Military Medal
