Personal History

William HEMINGWAY was born at Dewsbury, Yorkshire on 14 September 1894 the son of Harry and Jane Eliza HEMINGWAY nee HEALEY who were married 26/03/1894 at All Saints, Dewsbury, Yorkshire. His father died on .

In the 1911 census the family were living at 33, Peel Street, Dewsbury, Yorkshire,. He was aged 16 with the occupation of Woollen Mill Hand.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 15, Lower Peel Street, Dewsbury, Yorkshire,. He was aged 6 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Chief Goods Managers Dept. as a Porter

He enlisted in the Yorkshire Light Infantry at Dewsbury, Yorkshire.

He is recorded as Died on 12 August 1915 in 10th Stationary Hospital St Omer aged 20

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
