Personal History

Charles Henry HENDERSON was born at Liverpool, Lancashire in 1895 the son of Charles H. and Eliza Jane HENDERSON nee HEASLIP who were married 1893 at St. Peter, Liverpool, Lancashire.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 71, Grey Rock Street, West Derby Road, Liverpool, Lancashire,. He was aged 15 Railway Clerk

In the 1901 census the family were living at 71, Grey Rock Street, West Derby Road, Liverpool, Lancashire,. He was aged 5

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Chief Goods Managers Dept. at Liverpool as a Clerk

Service History

He was living at Everton, Liverpool when he enlisted in the King's Liverpool Regiment at Liverpool, Lancashire. on 20 April 1914 and embarked for France on 21 February 1915. His last known address was Liverpool. West Derby Road, Grey Rock Street, 71 (1911 Census).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 2 July 1916 aged 21

He was awarded the Victory Medal & British War Medal
