Personal History

Ebenezer HENDERSON was born at Kirkaldy, Fifeshire, Scotland in 1896 the son of George and Ann Paterson HENDERSON nee WALKER. His father died on .

In the 1911 census the family were living at 3, Pimlot Street, Pendleton, Salford, Lancashire,. He was aged 15 with the occupation of Wire Apprentice.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 54, Salisbury Road, Armley, Leeds, Yorkshire,. He was aged 5 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Superintendent of the Line at Atherton as a Porter

Service History

He enlisted in the Lancashire Fusiliers at Salford, Lancashire. and embarked for Balkans on 5 May 1915. His last known address was Salford, Pendleton, Pimlot Street, 1A CWGC

He is recorded as Killed in action on 21 July 1915 aged 19

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
