*In the 1901 census the family were living at 5, India Street, Summerseat, Bury, Lancashire,. He was aged 5 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Locomotive Dept. at Bury as a Cleaner*

***Service History***

*He enlisted in the Royal Field Artillery at Bolton, Lancashire.*

*He is recorded as Killed in action on 13 September 1917 aged 21*

*He was awarded the Victory Medal & British War Medal*
