Personal History

Daniel BALL was born at Hulme, Manchester in 1893 the son of Daniel and Alice BALL nee OGDEN who were married 1889 at St. John The Baptist, Hulme, Manchester. His father died in 1949. His mother died in 1949.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 8, Sorrell Street, Hulme, Manchester,. He was aged 17 with the occupation of Railway Vanman.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 10, Durham Street, Manchester,. He was aged 7

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Carriage and Wagon Dept. at Victoria as a Gasman

Service History

He was living at Ashton-On-Mersey, Lancashire when he enlisted in the Manchester Regiment.

He is recorded as Killed in action on 2 August 1916 aged 23

He was awarded the Victory Medal & British War Medal
