Personal History

Arthur HINCHCLIFFE was born at Bolton, Lancashire in 1890 the son of Thomas and Susan HINCHCLIFFE nee HARRISON who were married 14/10/1889 at St. Mark, Bolton, Lancashire. His father died in 1919. His mother died in 1919.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 210, Crecent Road, Bolton, Lancashire,. He was aged 20 with the occupation of Assistant Wireman - Railway.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 4, Castrian Street, Bolton, Lancashire,. He was aged 11

*In the 1891 census the family were living at 14, Ventuse Street, Bolton, Lancashire,. He was aged 8 months
He was a married man. His wife's name was Alice HINCHCLIFFE (nee MARTIN) They married at All Saints, Farnworth, Lancashire on 9 February 1916*

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Electrical Dept as an Assistant Wireman

He enlisted in the Royal Engineers.

He is recorded as Died on 18 February 1919 aged 28

He was awarded the Victory Medal & British War Medal
