*Thomas HINCHCLIFFE was born at Mottram, Cheshire in 1876.*

*He was a married man. His wife's name was Mary Jane HINCHCLIFFE (nee BURKS) They married at (Place unknown) on 9 March 1905. They had children: Maria b. 1890, Fanny b. 1898, Christoher b. 1900, Winnie b. 1901, Edith b. 1906, May b. 1906, Thomas b. 1910*

*Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company as a Cleaner*

### ***Service History***

*He was living at Hollingworth, Cheshire when he enlisted in the Sherwood Foresters at Glossop, Derbyshire. on 1 September 1914 and embarked for Balkans on 24 September 1915. His last known address was Hollingworth, Market Street, 24 (Attestation).*

*He is recorded as Died of Wounds on 28 May 1918*

*He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star*
