***Personal History***

*Robert HINDLE was born at Preston, Lancashire in 1891 the son of Alexander and Elizabeth Ann HINDLE nee SHACKLETON who were married 1874 at St. John, Preston, Lancashire.*

*In the 1911 census the family were living at 50, Gillet Street, Preston Lancashire,. He was aged 20 with the occupation of Labourer Saw Mills.*

*In the 1901 census the family were living at 25, Young Street, Preston, Lancashire,. He was aged 10*

*In the 1891 census the family were living at 25, Young Street, Preston, Lancashire,. He was aged 26 Days*

*Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Carriage and Wagon Dept. at Preston as a Washer*

***Service History***

*He enlisted in the Loyal North Lancashire Regiment at Preston, Lancashire. and embarked for France on 25 December 1915. His last known address was Preston, Gillet Street, 12 (CWGC).*

*He is recorded as Died of Wounds on 2 January 1916 in 24th Gen Hosp., Etaples, France aged 25*

*He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star*
