***Personal History***

*Richard BALL was born at Liverpool, Lancashire on 1896? the son of Richard and Jane BALL nee RILEY who were married 1892 at Ormskirk Register Office or Registrar Attended. His father died in 1937. His mother died in 1937.*

*In the 1911 census the family were living at 33, Derby Street, Ormskirk, Lancashire,. He was aged 15 with the occupation of Railway Goods Clerk.*

*In the 1901 census the family were living at Halsall Lane, Aughton,. He was aged 5*

*Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Chief Goods Managers Dept. at Victoria as a Clark*

***Service History***

*He enlisted in the Loyal North Lancashire Regiment at Preston, Lancashire. on 16 January 1911 and embarked for France on 25 September 1915. His last known address was Ormskirk, Green Lane, Isolation Hospital, "The Lodge" (CWGC).*

*He is recorded as Killed in action on 10 July 1916*

*He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star*
