Harry HODGSON was born at Halifax, Yorkshire in 1895 the son of Thomas Lee and Maria HODGSON nee HARRISON who were married 29/09/1883 at Parish Church, Halifax, Yorkshire. His father died on .

Line Dept. at Hlifax Station as a Parcel Porter
