Personal History

Thomas Tinswood HODGSON was born at Culthwaite, Cumberland in 1897 the son of James and Margaret HODGSON nee TINNISWOOD who were married 1891 at Lazenby, Penrith, Cumberland. His mother died in 1901.

In the 1911 census the family were living at Hunsonly, Cumberland,. He was aged 14 with the occupation of Scholar.

In the 1901 census the family were living at Brackenborough Cott. He was aged s with the occupation of Hesketh in the Forest, Plumpton, Age 4.

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company

He was living at Manchester, Lancashire when he enlisted in the Manchester Regiment at the same place.

He is recorded as Died at home on 29 January 1918 aged 20

He was awarded the Victory Medal & British War Medal
