Personal History

Leo ALLARD was born at Blackburn in 1896 the son of William and Elizabeth ALLARD.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 11, Carr Road, Nelson,. He was aged 14 with the occupation of Baker.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 55. King Street, Blackburn,. He was aged 4

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Locomotive Dept. at Formby as a Sub Station Assistant

Service History

He enlisted in the Royal Field Artillery at Seaforth, Lancashire. and embarked for France on 22 July 1915. His last known address was Nelson, Carr Road, 11 (1911 Census).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 16 October 1916 aged 20

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
