***Personal History***

*Patrick HOGAN was born at Claremorris, County Mayo, Ireland in 1891 the son of John and Mary HOGAN. In the 1911 census the family were living at 140, Harrowby Street, Harpurhey, Manchester, Lancashire,. He was aged 22 with the occupation of Railway Porter.*

*He was a married man. His wife's name was Margaret HOGAN (nee CROSS) They married at Prestwich, Manchester, Registrar Attended on 24 March 1905. They had children: John b. 1911*

*Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Chief Goods Dept. at Salford as a Porter*

***Service History***

*He enlisted in the Loyal North Lancashire Regiment at Manchester, Lancashire. and embarked for Balkans on 15 June 1915. His last known address was New York, USA, Columbus Avenue, 727 (CWGC).*

*He is recorded as Killed in action on 9 August 1915 aged 26*

*He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star*
