John Albert HOGG was born at Ancoats, Mancheste, Lancashire on 19 April 1897 the son of John James and Fanny HOGG nee JONES who were married 1893 at Prestwich, Registrar Attended.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 24, Canning Street, Ancoats, Manchester,. He was aged 14 with the occupation of Railway Cart Boy.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 18, Sandal Street, Manchester,. He was aged 4
Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company as a Shunter

He enlisted in the King's Own Royal Lancaster Regiment at Manchester, Lancashire. He is recorded as Killed in action on 23 September 1917 aged 20 He was awarded the Victory Medal & British War Medal
