Personal History

John Grenville HOLDEN was born at Ramsbottom, Lancashire in 1895 the son of John Kershaw and Jane Elizabeth HOLDEN nee ROGERSON who were married 06/04/1890 at St. Paul, Norder, Lancashire.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 191, Whalley Road, Shuttleworth. Lancashire,. He was aged 16 with the occupation of Railway Clerk.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 269 & 271, (Post Office) Rochdale Road, Shuttleworth, Lancashire,. He was aged 6

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company as a Railway Clerk

He was living at Ramsbottom, Lancashire when he enlisted in the Lancashire Fusiliers at Bury, Lancashire.

He is recorded as Died of Wounds on 9 November 1918 aged 23

He was awarded the Victory Medal & British War Medal
