Personal History

Robert Fenton HOLDEN was born at Adlington, Lancashire in 1876 the son of Thomas and Jane HOLDEN nee HALL.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 25, Pickering Street, Bolton, Lancashire,. He was aged 35 with the occupation of Joiners Labourer.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 672, Liverpool Road, Hindley, Ince, Lancashire,. He was aged 27 with the occupation of Collery Worker Below Ground.

In the 1891 census the family were living at 38, Heapey Road, Chorley, Lancashire,. He was aged 15 with the occupation of Cotton Spinners Piecer.

He was a married man. His wife's name was Msary Ann HOLDEN (nee STUTTARD) They married at St. Mary, Bury, Lancashire on 5 March 1904. They had children: Jennie b. 1910, d.1910

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Chief Civil Engineers Dept. at Bolton as a Joiners Labourer

Service History

He enlisted in the East Lancashire Regiment at Bolton, Lancashire. and embarked for France on 5 May 1915. His last known address was Bolton, Lancashire, Pickring Street, 25 (1911 Census).

He is recorded as Died on 8 June 1917 aged 41

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
