***Personal History***

*James HOLLINGHURST was born at Preston Lancashire in 1895 the son of Henry and Jane HOLLINGHURST nee TAYLOR who were married 1890 at Preston Register Office or Registrar Attended . His father died in 1950. His mother died in 1950.*

*In the 1911 census the family were living at 22, Catherine Street East, Horwich, Lancashire,. He was aged 16 with the occupation of Machinist in Fitters Shop.*

*In the 1901 census the family were living at 10, Catherine Street East, Horwich, Lancashire,. He was aged 6 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Locomotive Dept. at Horwich as a Shaper*

***Service History***

*He was living at Horwich, Lancashire when he enlisted in the Loyal North Lancashire Regiment at the same place. on 17 August 1914 and embarked for France on 4 May 1915. His last known address was Horwich, Catherine Street East, 22 (CWGC).*

*He is recorded as Killed in action on 15 June 1915 aged 20*

*He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star*
