## Personal History

Thomas HOLLINSHEAD was born at Swinton, Lancashire on 7 May 1895 the son of Charles and Ellen HOLLINSHEAD nee WINROW who were married 1891 at St. John, Pendlebury. His father died in 1942. His mother died in 1942.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 441, Moorside Road, Swinton, Lancashire,. He was aged 15 with the occupation of Railway Junior Clerk.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 40, Pendlebury Road, Swinton, Lancashirem. He was aged 5 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company as a Clerk

## Service History

He was living at Swinton, Lancashire when he enlisted in the Royal Army Medical Corps at Manchester, Lancashire. on 11 December 1915 and embarked for Italy on 14 April 1917. His last known address was Swinton, Mancester, Moorside Road, 341 (CWGC).

He is recorded as Died on 1 October 1917 in British Military Hospital, Italy aged 22 He was awarded the Victory Medal & British War Medal
