***Personal History***

*James HOLLOWES was born at Farnworth, Lancashire in 1898 the son of William and Alice HOLLOWES nee MOORS who were married 05/05/1897 at St. John the Evangelist, Farnworth & Kearsley. His father died in 1919. His mother died in 1919.*

*In the 1911 census the family were living at 65, Price Street, Farnworth, Bolton,. He was aged 13 with the occupation of Reacher in Cotton Mill.*

*In the 1901 census the family were living at 65, Price Street, Farnworth, Bolton,. He was aged 3*

*Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company as a Train Booker*

***Service History***

*He enlisted in the Manchester Regiment at Farnworth, Lancashire.*

*He is recorded as Killed in action on 13 January 1918 aged 20*

*He was awarded the Victory Medal & British War Medal*
