James HOLT was born at Horwich, Lancashire in 1900 the son of William and Mary E. HOLT nee WOODWARD who were married 1894 at Holy Trinity Church, Horwich, Lancashire. His father died on . In the 1911 census the family were living at 34, Beatrice Street, Horwich, Lancashire,. He was aged 11 with the occupation of Scholar.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 6, Dickenson Street, Horwich, Lancashire. He was aged 1 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Locomotive Dept. at Horwich as an Apprentice
