## Personal History

Francis HOOBAN was born at Ringstown, Mountrath, Ireland in 1887 the son of Joseph and Julia HOOBAN nee ROURKE who were married 02/10/1879 at Laois, Ireland.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 9, Upper Sconce, Brisha, Queens County, Ireland,. He was aged 13 with the occupation of Farmers Som.

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company

## Service History

He was living at Mountrath, Queens Cty, Ireland when he enlisted in the Manchester Regiment at Manchester, Lancashire.

He is recorded as Died of Wounds on 22 February 1918 in Accidentally Injured aged 29 He was awarded the Victory Medal & British War Medal
