Personal History

Arthur Douglas HOPKINSON was born at Manchester, Lancashire the son of James and Louisa HOPKINSON nee HUNTINGTON. His father died in 1923. His mother died in 1923.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 17. Southern Street, Goole,. He was aged 13 with the occupation of Junior Railway Shipping Clerk.

In the 1891 census the family were living at 129, Lower Bridge Street, Hooke, Goole, Yorkshire,. He was aged 3

He was a married man. His wife's name was Blanch HOPKINSON (nee EDWARDS) They married at St, Marks, Sculcoates, Hull, Yorkshire, Hull on 25 March 1905. They had children: Ivy Amy Louisa b. 1908, Daisey b. 1911

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company at Goole as a Shipping Clerk

He enlisted in the King's Own Yorkshire Light Infantry at Goole, Yorkshire.

He is recorded as Killed in action on 27 November 1917 aged 30

He was awarded the Victory Medal & British War Medal
