Personal History

Fred Briggs HORSMAN was born at Sowerby Bridge, Yorkshire in 1897 the son of Luke and Maria HORSMAN nee WHITWORTH who were married 1886 at Halifax, Yorkshire. His father died in 1927. His mother died in 1927.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 42, Bolton Brow, Soerby Bridge, Yorkshire,. He was aged 13 with the occupation of Cotton Piecer.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 46, Bolton Brow, Soerby Bridge, Yorkshire,. He was aged 3 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company

He enlisted in the Lancashire Fusiliers at Halifax, Yorkshire.

He is recorded as Killed in action on 12 April 1918 aged 20

He was awarded the Victory Medal & British War Medal
