Personal History

Albert HOULT was born at Liverpool, Lancashire in 1896 the son of Thomas and Mary HOULT nee ASHTON who were married 1883 at St. Aiden, Kirkdale, Liverpool, Lancashire. His mother died in 1913. In the 1911 census the family were living at 92, Fonthill Road, Kirkdale, Liverpool, Lancashire,. He was aged 15 with the occupation of Railway Labourer.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 2. Lancaster Street, Kirkdale, Lancashire,. He was aged 5
Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Stores Dept. at North
Docks as a Sheet Repairer

Service History

He was living at Kirkdale, Liverpool when he enlisted in the King's Liverpool Regiment at Liverpool, Lancashire. on 7 September 1914 and embarked for France on 4 September 1915. His last known address was Kirkdale, Liverpool, Fonthill Road, 92 _ CWGC

He is recorded as Killed in action on 28 September 1917 aged 21

He was awarded the Victory Medal & British War Medal
