Personal History

Archibald HOWARD was born at East Cowick, Yorkshire in 1881 the son of George and Mary HOWARD. His father died in 1936. His mother died in 1936.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 52, Fourth Avenue, Goole, Yorkshire.. He was aged 30 with the occupation of Dock Labourer.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 1, Back Quay Street, Goole, Yorkshire,. He was aged 20 with the occupation of Railway Labourer.

In the 1891 census the family were living at 2, Upper Cross Street, Goole, Yorkshire,. He was aged 11

He was a married man. His wife's name was Rose HOWARD (nee BROOK) They married at Goole, Yorkshire on 14 March 1905. They had children: Rose Hilda b 1901, Alice b.1903, Evelyn b. 1905, Cyril b. 1910, Doris b. 1914

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company

Service History

He was living at Goole, Yorkshire when he enlisted in the Mercantile Marine.

He is recorded as Died at sea on 6 May 1917 in 1½ Miles East of Roker Point Sunderland aged 36
