Personal History

Reginald HOWARD was born at Southport, Lancashire in 1892 the son of Richard and Elizabeth HOWARD nee WRIGHT who were married 1890 at St. Cuthberts, North Meols, Southport, Lancashire.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 4, Rufford Roadm Crossens, Southport, Lancashire,. He was aged 19 with the occupation of Railway Clerk.

In the 1901 census the family were living at Mafferking Road, Marshside, Southport, Lancashire,. He was aged 9

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company as a Railway Booking Clerk

Service History

He was living at Southport, Lancashire when he enlisted in the King's Liverpool Regiment at the same place. He is recorded as Killed in action on 20 September 1917 aged 26

He was awarded the Victory Medal & British War Medal
