Personal History

Harry Leslie HOWDEN was born at Blackburn, Lancashire in 1899 the son of Henry Slack Howden and Jane HOWDEN nee JACKSON OWEN who were married 1895 at St. Philip & St. Paul, Southport, Lancashire. His father died in 1929. His mother died in 1929.

In the 1911 census the family were living at Green Slate Villa, Moss Road, Orrell, Nr. Wigan, Lancashire,. He was aged 12 with the occupation of Scholar.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 34, St. James's Road, Orrell, Lancashire,. He was aged 2 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company as a Clerk

He was living at Wigan, Lancashire when he enlisted in the Royal Welsh Surrey Regiment at Orsmkirk, Lancashire.

He is recorded as Killed in action on 22 September 1917 aged 19 He was awarded the Victory Medal & British War Medal
