Thomas HULME was born at Horwich, Bolton, Lancashire in 1893 the son of John and Mary Angela HULME nee ECCLES who were married 1888 at Chorley Register Office or Registrar Attended. His father died in 1928. His mother died in 1928.

He enlisted in the Royal Engineers at Horwich. Lancashire. and embarked for France on 4 September 1915. His last known address was Horwich, Lancashire, Lee Lane, 93 (1911 Census).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 14 September 1916 in Salonika aged 23

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
