***Personal History***

*Henry HUSSIN was born at Liverpool, Lancashire on 20 July 1893 the son of Patrick and Mary HUSSIN nee MCFADDEN who were married 18/05/1884 at West Derby, Liverpool, Lancashire. His father died in 1942. His mother died in 1942.*

*In the 1911 census the family were living at 16, Romeo Street, Kirkdale, Liverpool, Lancashire,. He was aged 17 with the occupation of Railway Number Taking.*

*In the 1901 census the family were living at 16, Romeo Street, Kirkdale, Liverpool, Lancashire,. He was aged 7 (Named Michael H. Hussin)*

*Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company as a Porter*

***Service History***

*He enlisted in the Machine Gun Corps at Liverpool, Lancashire.*

*He is recorded as Killed in action on 19 April 1918 aged 24*

*He was awarded the Victory Medal & British War Medal*
