## Personal History

Henry HUSSIN was born at Liverpool, Lancashire on 20 July 1893 the son of Patrick and Mary HUSSIN nee MCFADDEN who were married 18/05/1884 at West Derby, Liverpool, Lancashire. His father died in 1942. His mother died in 1942.
