Frederick Charles IDDON was born at Preston, Lancashire on 10 February 1897 the son of James and Edith IDDON nee WILLIS who were married 07/01/1896 at Emmanuel, Preston. His father died in 1925. His mother died in 1925.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 286, Lancaster Road, Preston,. He was aged 14 with the occupation of Ctton Mill Warehouse Boy.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 5, Ormside Street, Preston,. He was aged 4
Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Supintendent of the
Line Dept. at Preston (East Lancashire) as a Train Booker

He is recorded as Killed in action on 31 May 1916 aged 19
