*Thomas IRELAND was born at Kirkham, Lancashire in 1886 the son of George and Mary Jane IRELAND nee RIDING who were married 1883 at Old Fylde Register Office or Registrar Attended . His father died in 1888. His mother died in 1888.*

*In the 1911 census the family were living at 33, Church Street, Kirkham, Lancashire,. He was aged 24m Joiner with the occupation of House Building.*

*In the 1901 census the family were living at 3, Dyer Street, Kirkham, Lancashire,. He was aged 14 with the occupation of Joiners Apprentice.*

*In the 1891 census the family were living at Pumpton Road, Little Plumpton, Lancashire,. He was aged 4 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company as a Platelayer*

*He enlisted in the Royal Engineers.*

*He is recorded as Died on 12 November 1918 aged 34*
