*Thomas JACKSON was born at Manchester, Lancashire in 1896 the son of Elizabeth JACKSON. His mother died in 1917.*

*In the 1911 census the family were living at 52, Gomm Street, Longsight, Manchester, Lancashire,. He was aged 15 with the occupation of Office Boy Grey Cloth Merch..*

*Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Carriage and Wagon dept. at Victoria as a Gasman*

***Service History***

*He enlisted in the Manchester Regiment at Manchester, Lancashire.*

*He is recorded as Killed in action on 1 July 1916 aged 20*

*He was awarded the Victory Medal & British War Medal*
