## Personal History

John William JEWITT was born at Heckmondwike, Yorkshire on 5 August 1879 the son of George Robson and Mary Ann JEWITT nee DESDEN who were married 29/02/1876 at Parish Church of Birstol, Yorkshire. His father died on.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 4, Alexandra Avenue, Blavckpool, Lancashire,. He was aged 40 with the occupation of Auctioneer.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 48, Manchester Road, Blackpool, Lancashire,. He was aged 21 with the occupation of Groom & Auctioneers Assistant.

In the 1891 census the family were living at Darley Street, Heckmondwike, Yorkshire,. He was aged 11 with the occupation of Scholar.

He was a married man. His wife's name was Msary Elizabeth JEWITT (nee EVANS) They married at Old Fylde Register Office or Registrar Attended on 14 March 1905. They had children: Florence Getrude b. 1901, George Robson, b. 1904, Mary Ann b. 1906, John William b. 1908,

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Locomotive Dept. at Mirfield as a Cleaner

## Service History

He enlisted in the King's Own Royal Lancaster Regiment at Blackpool, Lancashire. and embarked for Greece on 11 November 1915. His last known address was Blackpool, Durham Road, 12 (CWGC).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 19 September 1918 in Salonika aged 40

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
