Personal History

Harry JOHNSON was born at Southport, Lancashire the son of Harry and Sarah Ellen JOHNSON nee BEVERLEY who were married 1896 at Ormskirk Register Office or Registrar Attended .

In the 1901 census the family were living at 10, Old Park Lane, Southport, Lancashire,. He was aged 4 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Locomotive Dept. at Formby as a Draughtsman

He was living at Southport, Lancashire when he enlisted in the Scots Guards at Liverpool, Lancashire. and embarked for France on 14 January 1915. His last known address was Southport, Lancashire, Old Park Lane, 10 (1911 Census).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 25 January 1915 aged 17

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
