Personal History

Reginald William JOHNSON was born at Goole, Yorkshire in 1887 the son of Frederick W and Willemina JOHNSON nee JARDINE who were married 1884 at Goole, Yorkshire. His father died in 1908. His mother died in 1908.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 2, Weatherhill Street, Goole, Yorkshire,. He was aged 23 with the occupation of Shipping Clerk.

In the 1901 census the family were living at Weatherhill Street, Goole, Yorkshire,. He was aged 13 In the 1891 census the family were living at 22. Queens Avenue, Hook, Goole, Yorkshir,. He was aged 3 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Goole Steam Shipping at Gooles as a Clerk

Service History

He was living at Goole, Yorkshire when he enlisted in the East Yorkshire Regiment at Hull, Yorkshire. and embarked for Egypt on 22 December 1915. His last known address was Goole, Weatherhill Street, 2 (CWGC). He is recorded as Killed in action on 19 June 1918 aged 31

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
