Personal History

Harold JOHNSTON was born at Hull, Yorkshire in 1891 the son of Samuel and Annie JOHNSTON nee CUTTS (KITCHING) who were married 1884 at Goole, Yorkshire.

In the 1911 census the family were living at Clifton Gardens, Goole, Yorkshire,. He was aged 19 with the occupation of Railway Clerk.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 11, Alliance Street, Kingston-Upon-Hull, Yorkshire,. He was aged 10

He was a married man. His wife's name was Clementina JOHNSTON (nee SIMPSON) They married at St. John (Newington), Hull, Yorkshire on 28 March 1905. They had children: Vera B. b. 1917
Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company as a Clerk

He enlisted in the Royal Engineers. He is recorded as Died at sea on 4 May 1917 aged 27

He was awarded the Victory Medal & British War Medal
