Personal History

Albert JONES was born at Manchester, Lancashire in 1894 the son of William and Wlizabeth JONES nee PIMLOT(OWEN) who were married 23/03/1889 at Manchester Cathedral. His mother died in 1927.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 3, Chapter Street, Miles Platting, Manchester, Lancashire,. He was aged 17 with the occupation of Railway Goods Checker.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 9, Sidney Street, Beswick, Manchester, Lancashire,. He was aged 7

He was a married man. His wife's name was Elizabeth JONES (nee MCGOVERN) They married at St. Philllips, Bradford, Manchester on 17 January 1915. They had children: Albert b. 1915

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Chief Goods Managers Dept. at Red Bank, Oldham Road as a Checker

Service History

He enlisted in the Manchester Regiment at Manchester, Lancashire.

He is recorded as Died of Wounds on 18 July 1916 aged 22

He was awarded the Victory Medal & British War Medal
