Personal History

Harry (Harold Grange) JONES was born at Runcon, Cheshire in 1889 the son of Walter and Emma JONES nee GRANGE who were married 1888 at St. Mary, Great Sankey, Warrington, Cheshire.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 9, Stalnley Villas, Runcorm, Cheshire,. He was aged 21 with the occupation of Articled Pupil to Surveyor.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 9, Stalnley Villas, Runcorm, Cheshire,. He was aged 11 In the 1891 census the family were living at 6, Leinster Gardens, Runcorn,. He was aged 1.

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Chief Goods Managers Dept. as a Doorman

He was living at Runcorn, Cheshire when he enlisted in the Royal Engineers at Liverpool, Lancashire. He is recorded as Killed in action on 4 August 1916 aged 27 He was awarded the Victory Medal & British War Medal
