***Personal History***

*James BARLOW was born at Salford, Lancashire on 3 March 1893 the son of John William and Mary Jane BARLOW nee LALLY who were married 1877 at St Simon, Salford.*

*In the 1911 census the family were living at 34, Waterloo Street, Salford, Lancashire,. He was aged 18 with the occupation of Labourer at Railway Works.*

*In the 1901 census the family were living at 34, Waterloo Street, Salford, Lancashire,. He was aged 8 He was a married man. His wife's name was Alice BARLOW (nee HARDEN)*

*Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Chief Goods Managers Dept. at Salford as a Porter*

***Service History***

*He enlisted in the King's Liverpool Regiment at Salford, Lancashire. and embarked for France on 26 September 1915. His last known address was Salford, Derby Street, Franklin Street, 50 (CWGC).*

*He is recorded as Killed in action on 9 April 1917 aged 24*

*He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star*
