Personal History

John KELSEY was born at Hulme, Mancgester in 1893 the son of Joseph and Elizabeth KELSEY nee REYNOLDS who were married 1897 at Salford Register Office or Registrar Attended .

In the 1911 census the family were living at 123, Longfield Road, Todmorden, Lancashire (Reg. as John Reynolds). He was aged 18 Railway Porter

In the 1901 census the family were living at 51, George Street, Salford,. He was aged 7

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Superintendent of the Line Dept. at Todmorden as a Porter

Service History

He enlisted in the Lancashire Fusiliers at Todmorden, Lancashire. and embarked for Balkans on 5 May 1915. His last known address was Todmorden, Lancashire, Longfield Road, 123

He is recorded as Died of Wounds on 10 May 1915 in HT Francomia aged 22

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
